



Youth Futures Foundation grants programme Q&A

Q: Why are you pausing the grants programme?

A: Youth Futures Foundation has stepped up to support the youth employment sector through the Covid-19 pandemic, but this has put unanticipated demand on our resources. We want our grant making process to be fair and effective. This pause in our programme will enable us to use your feedback to revise our grant making process, ensure our guidance is clear and funds are focused where they will be most effective.

Q: I have completed the eligibility quiz, but not yet submitted the application. Can I still continue with the process?

A: Yes. All applicants that have successfully completed the eligibility quiz or submitted an application at stage one or two will be processed and, where successful, awards made.

Q: Will you be giving grants in the future?

A: The closing date for applications in 2020 is 9 November. We will be inviting applications again in spring 2021.

Q: Will the criteria be different?

A: We remain committed to supporting organisations that share our values and the evaluation of programmes which will support the most disadvantaged and discriminated against young people to move into meaningful employment. Between now and spring 2021 we will review our existing criteria to ensure funds are directed where they will be most impactful.
