

How to respond to our questions – a stepby-step guide

This guide provides additional support to answer the 'Grant Programme Questions' section of the application form.

Some questions in the application form include a set of bullet points referencing what we would like to know, with a suggested word count. You should ensure your answers cover **all** bullet points under each question.

The word counts suggested are intended to guide you on the relative effort to expend on each answer.

Your Intervention

1) Please describe how the intervention you deliver meets our definition of preemployment vocational training.

We would like you to include:

- Which specific jobs and sectors the intervention is focused on
- Where the intervention takes places
 - Geographical location(s)
 - Intervention setting(s)
- Details of the curriculum content
- Who delivers the intervention

If your **pre-employment vocational training** is part of a wider set of activities you deliver, please describe these activities and indicate the proportion (as a percentage) of **pre-employment vocational training** as part of these activities.

If the **pre-employment vocational training** intervention makes up less than 50% of the overall contact hours, it will not be considered.

Suggested word count: 400

2) Does your intervention also include a basic skills training component? If so, please explain how this meets our definition of basic skills training.

We would like you to include:

- How it seeks to help young people develop literacy, numeracy and/or digital skills
- What proportion of your intervention is basic skills training

If your intervention does not include a basic skills component, please leave this question blank. Your application will not be scored less if you do not deliver basic skills training.

3) Does your intervention have a set duration and set number of sessions?

Please enter duration using the most appropriate unit for your intervention (e.g. days, weeks or months). Please enter the number of sessions a young person receives during your intervention.

We will not consider interventions that are longer than 12 months.

4) How long have you been delivering the intervention described in your previous answers?

Interventions with no previous history of delivery will not be considered.

5) Is your intervention delivered in cycles (i.e. do sets or cohorts of young people start the intervention at a specific time(s) of the year) OR do you deliver services on a rolling-basis (as and when a young person is referred to you)?

- Whether a formal agreement is in place (e.g. a Service Level Agreement or a Memorandum of Understanding)
- Who processes the referral at your organisation and within what timeframe
- How is the referral partner and young person notified of the outcome

Suggested word count: Up to 200 per referral partner

12) Is your intervention typically oversubscribed (i.e. do you receive more eligible referrals than you are able to support)?

This question seeks to find out if oversubscription is one of the potential ways young people could be randomised so do not feel obliged to answer yes, unless your programme genuinely is oversubscribed.

If yes, please enter the number of referrals you decline per year. This number should only include referrals that have been declined where a young person **meets** your eligibility criteria.

Please describe how you currently decide which young people receive support when you are oversubscribed i.e. how do you prioritise who receives the intervention and who doesn't?

13) What other programmes or interventions are available to eligible young people if they weren't receiving support from your intervention?

We would like you to include:

- If relevant, a brief overview of other programmes or interventions that your organisation delivers
- If aware, a brief overview of other organisations that deliver similar programmes or interventions in your geographical area
- If, and how you signpost young people to alternative programmes or interventions
- If relevant, an acceptable answer is that there are no other programmes or interventions that are available to eligible young people

Suggested word count: 300

14) Sometimes to progress promising interventions to trial we need to scale up delivery to ensure our evaluation is informative. Could you successfully double your current annual delivery starting in autumn 2026 if required, and, if so, what would you need in order to achieve this?

If yes, we would like to understand:

- The steps you would take to scale up delivery
- The resources you would require to scale up delivery. Please consider resources associated with the direct delivery of the intervention, as well as core organisational operations and referral relationships in your answer.
- The timeframe required to double your current annual delivery
- The challenges or risks you foresee in achieving this by autumn 2026
- Any existing plans that you have to scale up delivery, and by when

If no, we would like to understand:

• The barriers or reasons that are preventing delivery from being scaled

Suggested word count: 400

Data Collection

15) Do you collect personally identifying data about the young people you deliver your intervention or services to (e.g. National Insurance Number, Unique Pupil Number, Date of Birth, Postcode, First/Last name)? How is this data managed and stored? (e.g. spreadsheet, CRM or database)

Please list the identifying data that you collect about the young people you deliver services to and describe the systems and processes involved with storing and managing this data.

Suggested word count: 200





16) Over the last 24 months how many young people aged 16-25 started your intervention and completed your intervention?

Please enter a number for intervention starts and intervention completions. The number of young people who completed your intervention should not exceed the number of starts.

17a) What outcomes do you measure for the young people you deliver your intervention to?

Please list all of the outcomes you measure for the intervention.

17b) Please specify up to three outcomes which you consider to be most central to the intervention. How do you measure these outcomes?

Only list the three outcomes most central to the intervention and describe how you measure each of these outcomes e.g. baseline and endline surveys, interviews with young people, comparisons to national/regional data, stakeholder feedback etc.

Suggested word count: Up to 100 per outcome

18) How many of the young people who completed your intervention over the last 24 months achieved the three outcomes you specified in question 17b?
